We finished Creation last week and this week we
will study Cain and Abel, and the Tower of

4th Grade Math:

Last week we practiced our place value skills to
one million. and sequencing. This week we
will review subtraction. We will use the
commutative and identity properties of
addition. Thursday we will have our first math
test on lessons 1-10.

4th Grade EL:
