### 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Math:

Last week we practiced our place value skills  
and sequencing. This week we will continue  
with place value to one million. We will use  
the commutative and identity properties of  
addition. Students will begin to review  
subtraction. Every Friday is a Math quiz or  
test.

### 4<sup>th</sup> Grade EL:

Students received our "Walk the Walls"  
competition last week. For every 100 pages  
read a student will receive a 'foot' to decorate  
and put up on the wall. Our class goal is to  
reach around the room by the end of the year,  
or earlier!! The students are racing me!!

We will have a spelling test this Friday on long  
'a' words. Students received their writing  
folders. We will be working on how to write a  
good paragraph. In Shurley we will learn the  
capitalization rules. In reading we will read  
stories about standing up for what is right.

7/8 EL: In our class last week we reviewed the  
punctuation and capitalization rules. This week  
in Shurley we will continue reviewing the parts of  
speech. This week we will read the story "Cub on  
the Mississippi" by Mark Twain from the student  
readers. Students will have various short writing  
assignments this week.
