Here are a few pieces of information that will help in the first few weeks:

Class starts at 8:30 and the door to the classroom will open at 8:15. If you need to drop your child off before 8:15, please sign him or her into B.A.S.E. Camp.

Pick up times are 11:30 am (half-day) or 1:00 pm (lunch bunch) or between 3:00-3:15 pm (afternoon blast). If your child is attending our B.A.S.E. Camp, we will check them in at 3:15 pm.

Sign in/out:

Please make sure you sign your child in and out each day. This is also true if you happen to drop off/pick up in a place like the playground, chapel, or library.

Before you Drop-off your Child:

Please have your child use the restroom and wash his or her hands before entering the classroom every morning. Also, please apply sunscreen to your child before he or she comes to school. If your child stays for an extended day, we will re-apply as needed. If your child requires a specific brand of sunscreen, please let me know. Thanks!

Things to Bring:

For rest time please provide a crib sheet and blanket for your child, that is the size needed for our cots. If they have a special cuddle toy they rest with, they may bring one. We request that your bedding is stored in a separate bag from your child's backpack. Please take these items home at the end of each week to wash. You are welcome to bring a water bottle for use in the classroom and on the playground. Please label your bottle with your child's name. Please remember to pack your child a lunch if they will be staying for lunch bunch/afternoon blast.
