In Christian learning, we have read and talked about Joseph and will be talking about Moses next. Our memory verse is Roman 8:28 "We know that for those who love God all things work together for good." Tomorrow we will be completing our

first unit. Next week, we will begin Unit 2 "God Blesses a Nation".

In writing, we have been working on making sentences in personal narratives. We will continue in developing our sentence writing in our journals.

In math, we had our first assessment and are beginning the study of addition facts +1 and +0. Also, identifying ordinal position to twelfth, weekdays and weekends.

In science we planted microgreens and are patiently waiting for them to sprout. We have been learning about the parts of plants and how seeds grow. We are headed to how plants differ. We will journal the growth of our microgreens. We will also have centers with leaf rubbing coming up.

Social Studies has been about rules and laws. We have had some great discussions and activities sorting rules at home and school. They have been great at participating and giving great examples. Good citizenship is next on the horizon.
